ITEM 1: Approve minutes from meeting held on Thursday; December 1, 2011

Motion to approve the minutes of the meeting was made by Mark Sturkie, seconded by Hilda Easley and carried a vote of 6: 0.

ITEM 2: Bus Stop Construction Project – Isaac Rangel, Engineering Assistant

Isaac Rangel discussed the progress of Phase II, and stated it is 65 percent complete. In regards to Phase II 32 out of the 44 assigned bus benches are complete, and this phase shall be completed approximately mid to end of April. Isaac informed the board that Phase III is complete, and the Engineering Department has successfully completed their inspection of the completed bus benches. The Texas Department of Licensing Regulation inspection is still pending, for Phase III. Isaac informed the board, in regards to the 13 requests for right of way from property or business owners, we have formally received 5 of those returned and signed. The request for the bus bench at 27th and Osage, the Engineering Department has not received a definite yes or no. The Engineering Department plans to install a bus bench at the other seven requests, and omit a portion proposed on the private property. There will be an estimation of a seven week bidding process for Phase IV, and it shall begin around the beginning of June.

ITEM 3: Bus Stop Project - Judy Phelps, Transit Manager

Judy Phelps discussed the new route maps, and handouts of the route maps were provided for the panel. Judy asked for suggestions or feedback in regards to the route maps. Judy informed the panel that the route information is available on the city website. Judy also stated that May 17th, 2012 is the proposed date to begin the new route change.
