ITEM 1: Approve the minutes from meeting held on June 5, 2014

Mark Sturkie called the meeting to order and asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Richard Wagner motioned and Jim Mitchell seconded. The motion carried with a vote of 5.0.

ITEM 2: Phase V Bus Stop Request Evaluation presented by Jonathan Beckham

Jonathan Beckham researched and presented 6 bus stop requests.

#1 – NE 10th and Hill: Request for route restructuring to access two locations (the County Barn and the U.S. Post Office). Two bus stops exist less than a block from request.

#2 – Route 7 – Cinema Drive: There is no access route, curb cuts or ramps along Cinema Drive from the I-40 Access Road and Amarillo Blvd. If this bus stop is added, then the Transit Department will not be able to add a bus stop at the Furr's Cafeteria on Soncy. The Department has received several requests for a bus stop at Furr's which will provide access to Red Robin, Jimmy Johns and Plaza Restaurants. Jim Mitchell suggested a checking a drive on the west side of the Post Office to see if a bus stop could be added at that location.

#3 – 29th & Bolton: This bus bench request has an existing pad but it is not ADA compliant and the area will need to be cleaned up to add curb ramps.

#4 – Between SW 3rd & Ama. Blvd on Western: This request is for a bus stop on Western north of SW 3rd. This request would take away service from other existing bus stops that are frequently used within the area.

#5 – Business 40 Access Road near Wallace and Gentry: This request is for a bus stop along the access road in front of an apartment complex located at Business 40. The speed limit is 55 mph and there is a drainage ditch at this location. There are two bus stops on the north side of the apartment complex at Wallace and Gentry.

#6 – Ama. Blvd & Travis: Bus stop request at the new Dollar General. TXDOT owns the right of way at this location and there is no accessible route, curbcuts or ramps. There are other pre-existing bus stops located within a short walk from this requested bus stop location.

No questions or comments from the board members. Mark Sturkie thanked Jonathan for his evaluations on the bus stop requests.
