DeDe Reynolds - Chairman, called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and a quorum was established.

ITEM I: First on the agenda was review of the previous meeting minutes.

David Hurt, Vice-Chairman, moved to approve the minutes as written for the Civil Service Commission meeting held on February 12, 2014. Lawrence Walker, Commissioner, seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as presented.

ITEM II: The lists of new employees, step increases, transfers, promotions, demotions, bypasses, temporary assignments and disciplinary actions were reviewed.

ITEM III: Eligibility registers for the rank of Fire Lieutenant was reviewed.
