3. **Update of the Amarillo Athletic Complex Phase II Project**

Staff will provide a construction update on the project as we near completion. The formal bid opening for site improvements at the Amarillo Athletic Complex was held on Thursday, November 15, 2012. L.A. Fuller & Sons Construction was awarded the project in the amount of \$1,021,140. Construction on the project began January 7, 2013. The project consists of the construction of four multi-use fields, 200 parking spaces and a concrete plaza with restroom just south of the existing Rick Klein Baseball Fields. The project is scheduled for completion August, 2013 and will be available for play in the fall of 2014.

Staff will provide an overview of the upcoming City View School Park improvements that will consist of park trail and playground lighting and placement of a pre-fabricated concrete restroom. These improvements are funded from this year's approved capital improvement budget.
