3. **2014 – 2015 Community Development Block Grant Application**

Parks Administration has recently submitted an application for 2014-2015 CDBG funds in the amount of \$175,000 for the construction of a splash pad at Glenwood Park. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development provides the funding for the Community Block Grant Program. Staff will present the grant application for 2014-2015 to the Park Commission and discuss the details of the proposed project.
