TITLE VI, PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT AND LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY
PLANS**

The City of Amarillo – Amarillo City Transit announces its Title VI, Public Engagement and Limited English Proficiency Plans are ready for review and comment.

49 CFR Section 21.7(a) as amended, establishes procedures and requirements for every application for financial assistance from FTA. The City of Amarillo must provide assurance that public transportation services will be carried out in compliance with the Department of Transportation's Title VI regulations. Title VI is a Federal Statute that provides no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance

The Federal Transit Administration also requires all fixed route public transportation providers to develop measurable standards for Vehicle Load, Vehicle Headway, On-time Performance and Service Availability.

The Plans are available for inspection between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday beginning March 6, 2015 thru March 15, 2015 at the City of Amarillo Transit Department, 801 SE 23rd Avenue, Amarillo Texas 79105.

Interested parties are hereby, afforded the opportunity to comment on the proposed Plans. Written comments may be submitted to the City of Amarillo, P.O. Box 1971, Amarillo, Texas 79105, Attention: Transit Manager Transit Department, or, Federal Transit Administration, 819 N. Taylor Street, Room 8A36, Fort Worth, Texas 76102. Comments will be accepted for 10 days beginning March 6, 2015 thru March 15, 2015. Comments are for informational purposes only.

Unless there is an objection regarding the above-proposed Plans, this notice will serve as the Final Notice of the City of Amarillo Title VI, Public Engagement and Limited English Proficiency Plans.

ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT
