

SECTION 3: Ballots shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code, as amended, and shall permit electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid measure which shall appear on the ballot substantially as follows:

"THE ISSUANCE OF \$31,500,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR PARK AND RECREATION FACILITIES"

The ballot relating to this election shall place the bond proposition as the first item prior to any other items that the City may submit to the voters at the November 5, 2013 election and each Election Administrator is so directed.

SECTION 4: The election precincts for this election and the polling places designated for each election precinct are shown in **Exhibit A**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution for all purposes. The election officers and maximum number of clerks for each polling place shall be determined and appointed in accordance with an agreement to conduct a joint election to be executed with the Potter County Elections Administrator and an agreement to conduct a joint election to be executed with the Randall County Elections Administrator (jointly, the "Contract").

On election day, the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

SECTION 5: The locations, dates and times for early voting for this election shall be as shown in **Exhibit B** which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution for all purposes. **Exhibit B** shall be modified to include additional early voting locations designated by the Potter County Elections Administrator and the Randall County Elections Administrator, as applicable, and to conform to the Contract. The Potter County Elections Administrator is hereby appointed early voting clerk and shall appoint and designate deputy clerks for early voting in accordance with the Contract for that portion of the City located in Potter County and the Randall County Elections Administrator is hereby appointed early voting clerk and shall appoint and designate deputy clerks for early voting in accordance with the Contract for that portion of the City located in Randall County.

For purposes of processing ballots cast in early voting, the election officers for the early voting ballot board for this election shall be appointed and designated in accordance with the provisions of the Contract.

SECTION 6: All resident qualified electors of the City shall be permitted to vote at said election, and on the day of the election, such electors shall vote at the polling place designated for the election precinct in which they reside. This election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, as amended, and Texas Government Code, Chapter 1251, as amended, and to the extent required by law, all election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.
