

INTRODUCTION

Over the past several decades, Amarillo has experienced many changes in population and housing. During the 1960s Amarillo experienced a population decline of nearly 8 %, but rebounded with a growth rate of nearly 18 % the following decade. With the Baby Boom generation growing older, the average age within the community is gradually increasing. Changes in population characteristics result in fluctuations in Amarillo's housing market. This publication will analyze the major differences in population and housing patterns for the City of Amarillo and the Amarillo Metropolitan Statistical Area (comprised of both Potter and Randall counties). The changes that occurred between 1990 and 2000 will be emphasized.

The data used to compile this document are from the 2000 Census Summary File 1 (SF 1) – 100% data. Summary File 1 presents counts and information (age, sex, race, Hispanic/Latino origin, household relationship, whether residence is owned or rented) collected from all people and housing units. Because some users of this publication will have a greater interest in what trends have occurred in their own neighborhood, certain census data have been provided by census tract. Some census tracts are exceptions to the trends occurring throughout the City; therefore, it should not be assumed that any particular census tract fits the general citywide trend.

This publication is the first of two reports generated to analyze the data provided from the 2000 Census. The second publication, to be published in late 2002 or early 2003, will analyze sample information attained from the 2000 Census long form. The second document commonly referred to as Changing Numbers, Part 2, will address the economic changes that have occurred in Amarillo during the 1990's and more detailed housing information.

GEOGRAPHIC COMPARISONS OF CENSUS DATA

The purpose of this publication is to compare 2000 Census data with 1990 information, and in some cases, census data from earlier years. Comparisons have become more complex because geographic areas have changed for some of the census tracts over the past few decades. An awareness of the geographic changes is critical when comparing the census tracts from decade to decade.

Some census tracts (abbreviated as "CT") in the Amarillo area did not have enough population to warrant being a separate census tract according to the Census Bureau's criteria.

The tracts have been combined as follows:

- ◆ 2000 **CT 133** is now just the western portion of 1990 CT 133.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 145** was created by combining 1990 CT 108 and CT 109.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 146** was created by combining most of 1990 CT 113 and northern portions of 1990 CT 112 & CT 114.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 147** was created by combining 1990 CT 105 and southern portions of 1990 CT 112, CT 113, & CT 114.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 148** was created by combining 1990 CT 121 & CT 129.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 149** was created by combining 1990 CT 123 & CT 125.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 150** was created by combining 1990 CT 127 & CT 128.97.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 151** was created by combining 1990 CT 135 & CT 136.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 152** was created by combining 1990 CT 137 & CT 138.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 153** was created by combining 1990 CT 131 & the eastern portion of 1990 CT 133.

Some census tract designations for the 2000 Census were made to correct errors the Census Bureau made in digitizing the 1990 Census maps. At the time the errors were made, the only solution was for the Census Bureau to designate new census tracts using unique .97 and .98 suffixes to the census tract numbering. For the 2000 Census, these errors have been corrected by properly renumbering the census tracts that were digitized in error. The 2000 corrections include:

- ◆ 2000 **CT 128** was 1990 CT 128.98.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 215** was corrected by combining 1990 CT 215 & CT 220.97.
- ◆ 2000 **CT 220** was 1990 CT 220.98.

Some census tracts met the Census Bureau's criteria to be divided into new census tracts.

- ◆ 1990 CT 217 was divided into 2000 **CT 217.01** and **CT 217.02**.

These geographic revisions and new census tract designations are somewhat difficult to understand; however, the changes must be kept in mind when comparing data on census tracts from one decade to another. For clarification on these changes, see Appendices A and B.

POPULATION

For the most part, the Amarillo MSA, Potter County, Randall County, and the City of Amarillo grew in population at a faster rate than that of the State of Texas between 1890 and 1970, as shown in the table, Population Growth 1890-2000 below. Of these entities, only Randall County’s growth rate exceeded that of the State from 1970 to 1990, but the 2000 Census indicates that Randall County’s growth rate was below that of the State as a whole. Table 1 below indicates a decline in the growth rate of the MSA, Potter County and the City of Amarillo during the 1960s. This decline is largely attributed to the closing of the Amarillo Air Force Base in July of 1969. It is estimated that the closing of the base resulted in a population loss of approximately 30,000 people, including enlisted personnel, their families, and civilian personnel.

Increased construction and subdivision platting activity during the mid-1970s allowed Amarillo to recover from this population loss. In fact, the MSA grew by about 8 % during the 1980s and by 16 % during the 1990s. This growth rate for the Amarillo MSA was 3 % greater than that of the U.S. during the past decade. Of the 24 MSA's in Texas, the Amarillo MSA ranked 13th in population in 2000 (see Appendix C). This is the same position it has held for the last three decades.

Potter County declined in population by 21.7 % during the 1960s. This was due primarily to the air base closing. During the 1980s, Potter County experienced a slight loss of population, but due to strong residential growth in Northwest Amarillo, as well as growth in the outlying areas north of Amarillo, Potter County population grew by 16 % during the 1990s. Potter County's 2000 population was 113,546. Randall County, on the other hand, has continued to grow even during the decade of the air base closing. During the 1960s, 1970s and 1980s, Randall County grew by 59 %, 39 % and 19.5 % respectively. Although Randall County's growth rate during the 1990s was not as high as in previous decades, the county did manage to post a strong 16.3 % growth rate.

The City of Amarillo, with a 1980 population of 149,230, demonstrated a remarkable recovery over the previous decade's 8 % population loss. The decade of the 1970s posted nearly an 18 % gain in population. Amarillo continued to grow almost another 6 % during the 1980s, posting a 1990 Census population of 157,615. The 2000 Census showed the City of Amarillo having 173,627 people which was about a 10% increase from the 1990 population. While the ranking of the MSA has been stable over the last 30 years, the City has fallen from ninth largest incorporated place in the state in 1970 to 14th in 2000 (see Appendix D). Four of the five cities that surpassed Amarillo in population (Arlington in 1980, Garland in 1990, and Plano, Irving and Laredo in 2000) are part of the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Statistical Area, the largest MSA in the state of Texas. More detailed data on population change by census tract can be found in Appendix E.

POPULATION CHANGE

During the decade between 1980 and 1990, the City of Amarillo had a population growth of almost 18 %, but the growth was confined primarily to the north, south and west parts of the City. Most other census tracts in the City lost population. In comparison for the decade between 1990 and 2000, the City grew at a slower rate (10 %), but the growth occurred throughout Amarillo. Of course some census tracts grew more rapidly than others, but only a few census tracts lost population during that ten year period.

Typically, rapid population growth occurs in the northwest and southwest areas of the City. This has occurred while the central portions of Amarillo have experienced population decline. In 1980, the center of Amarillo's population was located at the intersection of Interstate Highway 40 and Georgia Street.

Over the last 20 years, the center of the City's population has been moving to the southwest. In 1990, the center of population was located at S.W. 26th and Georgia, while in 2000, the population center of the City moved southwesterly to 34th and Paramount.

During the 1990s, 40 census tracts (74%) of the 54 census tracts inside the City gained in population. Only two census tracts (CT 216.07 and 220) more than doubled in population because of new residential developments that have occurred in those two census tracts. In-migration from smaller outlying communities in the Texas Panhandle is believed to be the reason for some of the growth in these 40 census tracts, along with families moving from one residence to another during this time period. Fourteen census tracts (26%) lost population, which was much lower than the 35 census tracts (40%) that lost population during the prior decade. Some areas of the City are experiencing a reduction in population through out-migration, an overall decline in birth rates, a reduction in housing stock, and the tendency for fewer people to reside in each household.

While those parts of the City with a declining population base are certain to face problems in the future, those areas with growing numbers are also being forced to make adjustments. Public funding may need to be increased in areas facing rapid development in order to add classrooms to existing schools or to build additional schools, and to increase the availability of other public services. The extension of City services, such as police and fire protection, sanitation collection, and utilities into growing areas of the City requires quick response by City departments so the needs of these rapidly developing areas can be met.

MALE / FEMALE DISTRIBUTION

The trend for the MSA, both counties, and the City is that females outnumber males. The only exception to this occurred during the 1960s when the air base was still operational. During this time, there were more males than females in the MSA, Potter County and the City of Amarillo. After the air base closed, females once again became the predominant population group and have remained so ever since, as shown in the table, Male / Female Distribution, at the top of **page 6**. In both 1990 and 2000, there were 92 males to every 100 females.

Comparable to 1980 and 1990, the 2000 Census shows there are more males than females under the age of 17 in Amarillo. After the age of 17, however, females dominate all age groups, particularly those age 55 and over. Between the ages of 18 and 54, there were 95 males to every 100 females. This ratio changed dramatically in the age groups over 65, where there were only 67 males to every 100 females. The table, Males & Females by Age Groups, 2000, at the bottom of **page 6**, shows the predominant number of females in different age levels. More detailed data on male/female composition by age can be found in Appendix F.

MARITAL STATUS

During the past 30 years, there has been one very notable trend in the marital status of the City's population – the percentage of divorced people has substantially increased from 4.7% in 1970 to 11.8% in 2000). At the same time, the percentage of married people has decreased from 67% in 1970 to 56.3% in 2000. People who are single, separated, or widowed increased slightly from 28% in 1970 to 32% in 2000. Potter and Randall counties and the Amarillo MSA experienced similar trends. Randall County had a higher percentage of people who were married (61.4%), while Potter County had higher percentages of people who were never married (22.5%), separated (3.5%), widowed (7.4%), and divorced (11.9%). Appendix G shows the marital status of people in Potter and Randall counties, the Amarillo MSA, and the City of Amarillo.


AGE DISTRIBUTION

The overall age of a community's population is an indicator of whether the community is maturing or, in general, becoming younger. In Amarillo's case, the population is becoming older. The illustration on the following page, "Age Distribution 1940-1990," provides a graphic representation of the fluctuations in the various age groups. As the graph shows, there were high proportions of young people during the 1950's and 1960's. This was a direct result of the Baby Boom generation. As this generation continues to age, an increase in the 35-64 age group will become more noticeable.

During the three decades since 1970, Amarillo has been experiencing a population decrease in the Under 20 age groups. In addition to this trend, the Over 35 age groups are expected to increase in proportion to Amarillo's total population at a faster rate than any other age group. This trend is expected to continue in the future as well. Total population figures by age from 1940 to 2000 are listed for the City, the Amarillo MSA, and both counties in Appendices H through K. Census tract population by age for 1970 through 2000 can be found in Appendix L. This information may be helpful in planning for community centers, recreation activities, or other facilities that may need to target specific age groups by geographic area.



The primary changes from 1960 to 2000 in age composition for the Amarillo area reveal two essential trends. The first trend is described as having a decreasing proportion of people under 20 years of age. This is due to a decrease in birth rates. The second trend is described as having an increasing number of older people. This has resulted from a continued decline in death rates, as well as from the aging of the Baby Boom generation. In 1960, people under the age of 20 made up 42 % of the City's population. By 2000, this number had decreased to 31 %. Conversely, in 1960, people over the age of 45 made up 22 % of the population. By 2000, this percentage had increased to 33 % of the City's population. The 20 – 44 age groups have remained relatively unchanged since 1960. In 1960, these people accounted for 36 % of the total City population which is the same percentage found in the 2000 Census.


Age Distribution 1940 - 2000



The maps, People Under 18 Years of Age (1990 & 2000), on **page 9** illustrate how the percentage of children under 18 years of age has changed geographically (by census tract) between 1990 and 2000. In 1970, one-third of all census tracts in the City of Amarillo had children comprising over 40 % of the total tract population. In 1980, there were only four tracts, and by 1990 there was none. For 2000, there are still no census tracts that contain more than 40% children. Twenty-two census tracts decreased in their percentage of children during the 1990's, while 19 census tracts increased. The largest increases occurred in census tracts 216.07 (700%) which includes newly developing neighborhoods such as Westover, the Colonies and The Greenways and census tract 122 (42%), that includes Holland and Ridgemere additions. The largest declines occurred in census tracts 206 (-19%) that includes Grandview and Oakdale Subdivisions and census tract 216.03 (-26%) that consists of Puckett West Subdivision. Appendix M shows the actual numbers and percentages of children under the age of 18 by census tract from 1970 to 2000.

The increased number of people 65 years and older, and their increased proportion of the population, has resulted in the need for more attention to be given to the issues facing this segment of society. Such issues include different types of pension and retirement plans, special housing facilities, institutional facilities for the aged, and the expansion of senior citizen recreational services. Due to their increasing numbers, considerable political strength has been gained by the aged through such groups as the American Association of Retired Persons (AARP). In Amarillo, people 65 years and older accounted for 12.0 % of the total population in 1990, and 12.6 % in 2000. While the 65 and over population group has not significantly increased in proportion to the total Amarillo population, the number of senior citizens have increased 45 % since 1980. The maps on **page 10** illustrating Persons 65 Years of Age and Over indicate changes that have occurred within the 65 and Over population group by census tract as stated in the 1990 and 2000 Censuses.


DEPENDENCY RATIO

A population may be divided into two groups based upon the stage of life people have attained. These two broad groups are the economically dependent and the economically productive. The relative size of the economically dependent and the economically productive groups at any given point in time can have important implications in terms of economic production, tax structure, institutional and governmental needs, and other social services.

The economically dependent are defined as children under 15 years of age and people 65 years of age and over. Economically dependent people are not expected to be economically productive, and therefore, are dependent upon the productive people of the community. The economically productive group encompasses all the remaining people in the community, or those between the ages of 16 and 64.

A ratio has been devised which indicates the burden of support borne by the productive members of the population. This ratio is generated by dividing the number of people under 15 years of age and over 65 years of age (the dependent population) by the number of people 16 through 64 years of age (the productive population). The resulting figure, multiplied by 1,000, is referred to as the dependency ratio of a population. This ratio indicates the number of dependent people for every 1,000 people of wage-earning age. The Amarillo MSA dependency ratio in 1960 was 713. This ratio has been steadily decreasing over the past 40 years, and in 2000 the ratio was 524. The City of Amarillo also has a declining dependency ratio. The ratio was 716 in 1960, but had declined to 562 by 2000. The graph on **page 12** illustrating Dependency Ratios 1940 – 2000 indicates changes in the City's and MSA's dependency ratio over the last half century.


Dependency Ratios 1940 - 2000



INDEX OF AGING

Although people in the two extreme age groups (Under 15 and 65 and Over) are classified as the economically-dependent population, each of the two groups plays a different role in the community through the different types of goods and services they require. Further insight regarding the importance of the two age groups may be gained by comparing their rates of growth. This type of comparison is accomplished through the development of an index. This index is created by dividing the number of people 65 years and older by the number of people under the age of 15. The resulting figure is then multiplied by 100 to produce an index of aging. The number of people age 65 years and older, in relation to those less than 15 years of age, has generally increased since 1940. In 1940, there were only 16 senior citizens per 100 young people in both the City and the MSA. The graph on **page 13** entitled Index of Aging 1940 – 2000, shows the fluctuation in the index between 1940 and 2000. In 2000, the City and MSA had an index of 54 and 52, respectively. It is clear that older people make up a significantly larger proportion of the population than they did during the middle of the century. This trend is expected to continue as the Baby Boom generation enters the more dependent stage of their lives.

RACIAL AND ETHNIC COMPOSITION

Five major race classifications and one ethnic characteristic classification are distinguished by the Bureau of Census: White; Black; American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut; Asian or Pacific Islander; Other Races; and Hispanic (ethnic characteristic). For the 2000 Census, another category was added entitled “Two or More Races” for individuals who are of more than one race. In 1980, Whites made up 83 % of Amarillo's total population and decreased to 77 % in 1990. The 2000 Census indicates that the White population dropped to 68 % of the population. This reduction in percentage can be attributed the large increase in the Hispanic population.

In 1970, there were 51 City census tracts (out of 58 total census tracts) that contained 75 % or more White population. By 1980, this had changed to 45 census tracts (out of 59 total census tracts) and in 1990, there were 41 census tracts (out of 63 total census tracts). In 2000, 31 census tracts (out of 53 total census tracts) had 75 % or more White population. In 2000, the census tracts with the highest concentration of White people were located in the western and southwestern portions of Amarillo (see map, Concentrations of White Population, on **page 15**). Whereas the White population has been decreasing as a percentage of the total population, minority populations have been increasing, as shown in the table, % Change in Race/Ethnicity, on **page 14**. The Hispanic population had the largest increase in numbers, from 23,231 in 1990 to 37,947 in 2000 that equates to a 63 % increase. Asian and Pacific Islanders also had a large percentage (25%) increase in population during the past decade. American Indian, Eskimo or

Aleut population slightly decreased (-1%). Changes in actual population for each minority group are shown in the graph "Trends in Minority Populations, 1970-2000" on page 14. Appendix N shows 1990 and 2000 race by age for the City of Amarillo while Appendix O lists race by census tract from 1970 through 2000 for the City of Amarillo.





Hispanic Persons

Although the Census Bureau considered Hispanic as an ethnic characteristic in 1980, 1990, and 2000 Censuses, Hispanic figures are reported by the Census Bureau so they may be compared numerically with other races. In the 2000 Census, Hispanics are the principal non-White minority group in Amarillo making up 21.9 % of the City's population and 69 % of the total non-White population. In comparison, people of Spanish language and Spanish surname comprised 6.6 % of the City's population in 1970, and by 1980, accounted for 9.2 % of the City's population. In 1990, people of Hispanic origin comprised 14.7 % of Amarillo's population.

The Hispanic population is not only the largest non-White population in Amarillo, it is also the fastest growing segment of the population. Between 1970 and 2000, the Hispanic population more than almost tripled in number and outpaced all other racial group's growth rate. (see Race/Ethnicity table on **page 14**).

This high rate of growth for Hispanics is expected to continue due to provisions of the Immigration and Naturalization Act of 1986. According to the Act, any person who has been granted legalization through a permanent residential visa is eligible to move their immediate families into the country to live with them.


The Hispanic population in Amarillo is young in that 41 % were under 18 years of age in 2000, compared to 28 % being under 18 for the total City population. There is an extremely low percentage (3%) of elderly Hispanics in Amarillo, compared to 13 % of the entire City population.

Only three census tracts within the City were over 10 % Spanish in 1970 that increased to six census tracts by 1980. In 1990, there were 14 census tracts with more than 20 % of their population being of Hispanic which grew to 20 census tracts in 2000, as shown on the map of Concentrations of Hispanic Population on **page 17**.


Black Persons

The City of Amarillo's Black population accounted for 5.3 % of the total population in 1970, 5.5 % in 1980, and 5.8 % in 1990 and in 2000. In 2000, this represented a total growth in the Black community of 50 % between 1970 and 2000 (see Race/Ethnicity table and Trends in Minority Population graph on **page 14**).

Since 1980, the percentage of the Black population has remained relatively unchanged at approximately 6 %. The Black population is young, in that 38 % of the Blacks in Amarillo were under 18 years of age in 2000, compared to 28 % for the total City population. The proportion of the Black population 65 and over was 8 %, in contrast to 13 % of the entire City population.




The Black population is concentrated in the northern and north central portions of the City, as shown on the map, Concentrations of Black Population. The 2000 Census indicated that 82 % of the residents in Census Tract 130 were Black, while 51 % were Black in Census Tract 148 and 46 % in Census Tract 139. These areas of the City also had concentrations of Black people in previous censuses.



Asian or Pacific Islanders

In Amarillo, the Asian or Pacific Islander population consists primarily of Laotian and Vietnamese people. There were 3,526 Asian or Pacific Islanders in the City in 2000, which represents 2 % of the total population. This was a 25 % increase in this racial population during the past decade (see Race/Ethnicity table and Trends in Minority Population graph on **page 14**). People of this race reside predominantly in the north central and northeastern areas of Amarillo, as shown on the map below. Census tract 149 has the largest number with 1,709 (30% of the census tract) being Asian/Pacific Islanders. A cultural characteristic of this population segment is that many often live in large extended families.




American Indian, Eskimo or Aleut

In 2000, there were 948 American Indians, Eskimos, or Aleutians in the City of Amarillo. This was about the same number as resided in Amarillo in 1990. This population group accounted for less than 1 % of Amarillo's total population in 2000.

There were nine census tracts in 2000 that had over 30 people of the American Indian, Eskimo or Aleutian race. Census Tract 211 had the largest proportion of this population with a total of 49 people. The map below shows areas of concentrations of American Indians, Eskimos or Aleutian.

SINGLE HEAD OF HOUSEHOLDS WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN

Single parent households are a growing segment of the population. Between 1990 and 2000, the number of single head of households with children under 18 increased by 39 %. The 1990 Census was the first time in which the number of male-headed households with dependent children was reported and was again reported in the 2000 Census. In 2000, there were 6,363 female householders (no husband present) with dependent children and 1,854 male householders (no wife present) with dependent children. In 1990, there were 4,807 female householders (no husband present) with dependent children and 1,121 male householders (no wife present) with dependent children. Appendix P lists female-headed households (no husband present) and male-headed households (no wife present) with children under 18 years of age by census tract.

While no gender bias is intended, households headed by females with dependent children generally have lower family incomes. For instance in August 2002, of the family households with dependent children (835) that were on the waiting list for assisted housing in Amarillo, 89 % were female-headed households with dependent children. Conversely, the remaining 11 % were male-headed households with dependent children. Also, out of the total 1,394 families on the waiting list for assisted housing in Amarillo, 1,105 (79 %) were female-headed households and the remaining 289 (21 %) were male-headed households. This socio-economic trend is of great concern to many public and private agencies, and has resulted in the development of many programs that are targeted to help single head of household families with dependent children.

HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS

Housing is a major determinant of a city's quality of life. Housing stock, affordability, and location are all major factors that relate to this. In order to plan for and project future housing needs it is necessary to observe past and present population characteristics. In addition, past and present housing characteristics, such as occupancy status, population per household, and quality features must also be observed. When this is done, the ability to forecast housing supply and demand is increased, and the gap between the two can be narrowed.


HOUSING SUPPLY

During the past decade, the City of Amarillo's housing supply grew 5.6 %. As of April 1, 2000, there were 72,408 year-round housing units within the City, or 3,816 more than in 1990. As the Housing Units 1950 – 2000 table on **page 22** shows, this increase in housing units was not as great as that which occurred during the previous decade, but nevertheless affirms the trend that Amarillo's housing supply is growing at a steady rate.

Furthermore, when the 6 % growth in housing supply is compared to the 10 % growth in population for the City of Amarillo, it becomes apparent that the availability of housing per person is decreasing. The same follows for the Amarillo MSA, where the 16.2 % population growth is about double that of the 8.8 % growth in housing supply.

The map on **page 22** illustrating Housing Supply Changes 1990-2000 depicts the Amarillo census tracts that showed a marked increase or decrease in the number of housing units. As was noted earlier, during the past decade Amarillo gained 3,816 housing units. The majority of this growth occurred on the City's periphery. Specifically, growth in housing supply was concentrated in the south, southwest, and northwest areas of the City. Census Tract 216.07 showed the largest increase in housing supply (southwest part of the City including Westover, Greenways and The Colonies subdivisions). Between 1990 and 2000, 797 housing units were added in this census tract.

As was the case during the 1970s and 1980s, the central area of Amarillo saw a reduction in housing supply during the 1990s. The 1990 Census Tracts 105, 112, 113, and 114 that contain the Central Business District was combined into two tracts (Census Tracts 146 and 147) for the 2000 Census and showed a 9.7 % decrease in housing supply. Between 1990 and 2000, these tracts lost a total of 293 units.

Similarly, 1990 Census Tracts 121 and 129 (located to the north of the Central Business District) and were renumbered to Census Tract 148 for the 2000 Census, lost 70 units, which amounts to a 6 % reduction in its housing supply. Appendix Q shows numerical and percentage changes in housing supplies by census tract between 1970 and 2000.

OCCUPANCY STATUS


In 2000, the City of Amarillo had 67,699 occupied residences, which equated to an occupancy rate of 93.5 %. This percentage was higher than that reported during the 1990 Census, when there were 61,137 occupied residences and an occupancy rate of 89.1 %. In 1980, the City's occupancy rate was 93.3 % and in 1970, it was 87.5 %. This low number for 1970 was a direct result of the closing of the air base in the late 1960s.

In 1990, six census tracts had occupancy rates below 80 %, whereas in 2000 the lowest occupancy rate in any census tract was 81.7 % (in Census Tract 146 in downtown Amarillo). Census Tract 216.03 (Puckett West subdivision) in the southwest part of the City had the highest occupancy rate of 99.4 %.

Housing supply and occupancy figures by census tract for 1970 through 2000 are included in Appendix R. Of the 67,699 occupied residential units within Amarillo, 42,866 (63.3%) of these units were owner-occupied. The remaining 24,833 units (36.7%) were renter-occupied. For the past three decades, both the northern and southwestern census tracts had a high majority of housing units that were owner-occupied. Appendix R details tenure (owners/renters) by census tract for 1980, 1990 and 2000.

POPULATION PER HOUSEHOLD

As was the case during the 1970s and 1980s, the average household size in Amarillo continued to decrease during the 1990s. In 1980 the average household size was 2.63 which decreased to 2.54 people per household in 1990. By 2000 the number of people per household had decreased even further to 2.53. This decline in people per household reflected the demographics of the past two decades, in which lower birth rates and higher divorce rates prevailed, and the number of people living alone increased. This decrease in average population per household is detailed in Appendix S, which reveals the average population per household by census tract for the years 1970 through 2000. The 2000 average population per household is shown by census tract on the map, Average Population Per Household 2000, below. As can be seen, the census tracts with the greatest population per household are located in the northeastern, central, and southwestern sections of the City. For more detail on population per household by census tract, Appendix T details household size by number of people in each household.







Changes in Census Tracts by Decennial Census






