ITEM 1. Call to Order

Chairman Murguia called the meeting to order at 12:00 P.M.

<u>ITEM 2.</u> Minutes – August 31, 2017

Chairman Murguia asked for corrections, deletions or changes to the minutes of August 31, 2017. Motion was made by Mr. Betancourt, seconded by Mr. Reed, to approve the minutes as submitted. Motion passed unanimously.

<u>ITEM 3.</u> Discussion and Consideration of the election of Officers for the Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone #2

On a motion by Mr. Kitten, and a second by Ms. Burton, John Betancourt was approved unanimously to serve as Vice-Chairman for the TIRZ #2 Board.

<u>ITEM 4.</u> Presentation and Discussion of TIRZ incentive options, examples from other cities, and history/timeline of TIRZ #1 projects

Mr. Freeman gave a brief presentation of examples from other cities, followed by the history and timeline of TIRZ #1 projects'. Mr. Shaw added the TIRZ #1 Board set up the Strategic Action Plan which helped develop a policy outlining specifics that interested the Board. Mr. Shaw stated Richard Brown, and Beth Duke, were instrumental in the creation of TIRZ #1. Chairman Murguia suggested collaborating with the main developers in the area to discuss their vision and timelines, which in turn will help the Board on the ultimate goals for the property.

Chairman Murguia inquired if these developers could be present at the next Board meeting.

ITEM 5. Discuss and Consideration of Final Project and Financing Plan for TIRZ #2

Mr. Freeman advised the Final Project and Financing Plan is basically the same as previously presented, with a slight revision in the maps, page 15 reveals \$39.9m in taxable values for the base year, and page 16 of the TIRZ Revenue Model has the 2017 numbers from the participating entities. Chairman Murguia inquired if the changes were given to City Council. Ms. Bonner advised the numbers presented today are the numbers the City Council unanimously approved as the 2017/2018 budget. Mr. Freeman advised if the Board approves this item, the next step will be the presentation to the City Council for their approval, as well as each taxing entity.

Motion was made by Mr. Frigo, seconded by Mr. Betancourt, to approve the Final Project and Financing Plan for TIRZ #2, as submitted. Motion passed unanimously.

ITEM 6. Discussion of Participation Agreements

Mr. Freeman briefly reviewed the Participation Agreement, advising the agreement is identical to TIRZ #1. No action is needed.

ITEM 7. Public Comment

No public comments were given.

ITEM 8. Discussion – Future Agenda Items

The following were discussed as possible items to be included on future agendas: the resignation of Kim May, and a new appointment to the Board; a draft update on the policy and an application for TIRZ #2; and potential dialogue with the main developers to discuss their future plans.
