- Purpose of Community Engagement

 - Level 1 = Modest impact, focused reach

Chapter 8 – 2: Animals and Fowl

Sec. 8-2-1. Definitions

• Creation:

- Abandonment
- Breed
- Breeder
- Intact

Definitions = Foundation

Sec. 8-2-15. Transfer of custody

- Current stray hold 3 days
 - Does not include:
 - Days Closed to Public
 - Holidays
 - Sundays and Mondays
- Reclaim Rate: 10-12%
- Reduce Stray hold to 2 days
 - Eliminate barriers to live outcomes
 - (TZI Supported)

Sec. 8-2-2. Enforcement

- Offense to interfere
 - Remove an animal from an AAM&W vehicle
 - Normal course of duties

Sec. 8-2-6. Inhumane Treatment

Cannot abandon an animal anywhere

- Owner is known
 - Notified by AAM&W
 - 1 business day to reclaim
 - Failure = Citation
- Rabies Tag
- Custom Tag
- Microchip
- Tattoo


Sec. 8-2-59. Mandatory Spay/Neuter

3 year period – Impounded 2 or more times

Must be fixed (Spayed/Neutered)

- Opt-Out Fee
- \$500.00 per occurrence

Severe Animal Overpopulation



Projected Euthanasia without Rescues

Current 3-Year Average – Euthanasia Rate – 31.91%

Euthanasia Rate without Destination Rescues – 59.23%

Difference – 27.32% increase without Destination Rescues

Current 3-Year Average – Live Release Rate – 68.09%

Live Release Rate without Destination Rescues – 40.77%

Difference – 27.32% decrease without Destination Rescues

- Cost Recovery \$~105.00
 - Euthanize (Land filled) \$1,401,750.00
 - 2015 5,080 qty \$533,400.00
 - 2016 3,387 qty \$355,635.00
 - 2017 4,063 qty \$426,615.00
 - 2018 820 qty \$86,100.00
 - Transfer out (To other communities) -\$1,186,080.00
 - 2015 2,549 qty \$267,645.00
 - 2016 4,172 qty \$438,060.00
 - 2017 3,549 qty \$372,645.00
 - 2018 1,026 qty \$107,730.00





- Applies Dogs and Cats
- Application Process
 - Strict Criteria
 - Unique Number issued
 - Each litter is a new permit
- Revoking Permit
 - Failure to comply once issued
- Fees:
 - Pre-birth \$500.00
 Post-Birth \$1,000.00

Sec. 8-2-88- Breeder's Ordinance

- Sell Liquor/Alcohol = Liquor License
- Own a business = Business License
- Own a restaurant = Restaurant License
- Build a building = Building Permit
- Electrical/Plumbing =
 - Electrical/Plumbing Permit
- Have a parade = Parade Permit
- Transport materials = DOT Permit

Parallel Examples: Cost of doing business

• Must have Breeder's Permit to:

Sell

Rent

Trade Giveaway Lease Market

Intact puppies or kitten

- After obtaining Breeder's Permit:
 - Transactions cannot occur in public
- Does not exempt from any other city requirements.
- Advertising
 - Unique Breeder's Permit number
 - Must be included



Prohibited Transactions

Prohibited Transactions Will not apply to:

- Agriculture based events
- Tax-exempt non-profits:
 - Humane Sanctuaries
 - Shelters
 - Organizations for abandoned or unwanted
- Zoos
- Circuses

Surrender Fee

- Citizens will incur partial cost
- \$20.00 (Draft version)

- Conceptually Considered (Managed Intake)
 - \$105.00 Cost Recovery
 - \$50.00 Additional Convenience
 - \$20.00 End of Life Euthanasia

Sec. 8-2-58 Spay/Neuter Fund

- Established
 - Surrender Fees
 - Breeder's Fees
 - Pre and Post Birth
 - Opt-Out
- Revenue kept separate from GR (General Revenue) Fund.
- Allocated during yearly budgeting process
 - Focus Spay/Neuter




Changes To Shelter Process


- Managed Intake
 - Take control of shelter's intake
 - Require Citizens to work with shelter to schedule
 - Vaccinate
 - Microchip
 - Determine proper placement
 - Fee's waived if owner works with AAM&W


