Intermediate - Field Inspection of 2015 International Residential Code Review - Chapters 1 - 10 & Reference Standards

**When:** August 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> 2018 and August 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> 2018.

**Scope:** A moderately-paced course that provides an in-depth view of the IRC, chapters 1 - 10 & 44 dealing with many facets and issues of 2015 IRC. Catch major and minor code items that will help improve the inspection process in the field. Administration rules, definitions, fire and life safety aspects, soil conditions & excavation, footing size and strength, placement of concrete, slab-on-grade, reinforcing steel, anchorage, retaining walls, light conventional wood-frame construction, load paths, notching and boring, girders and headers, connections and brace walls, and roofing provisions of rafters and roof truss will be covered. This course is applicable to all aspects of the design/construction/regulatory community, including contractors and design professionals.
