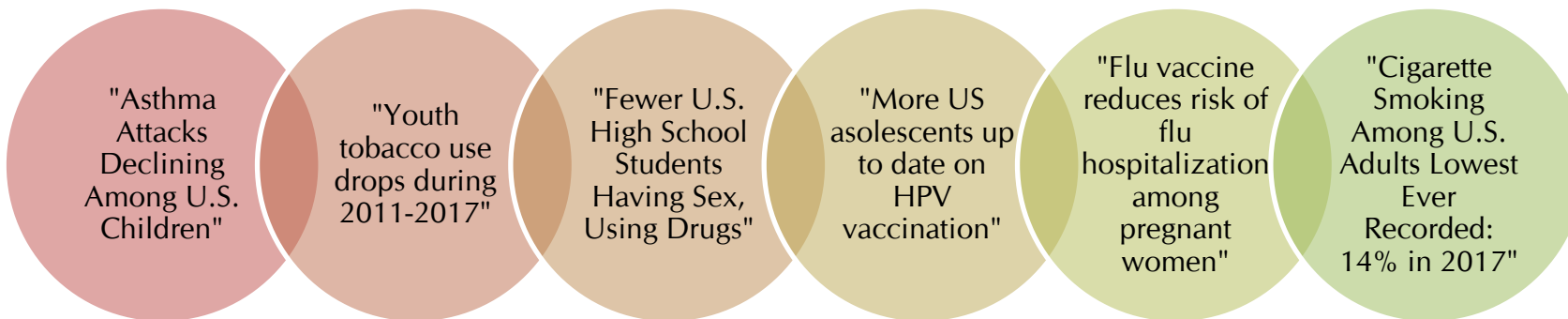
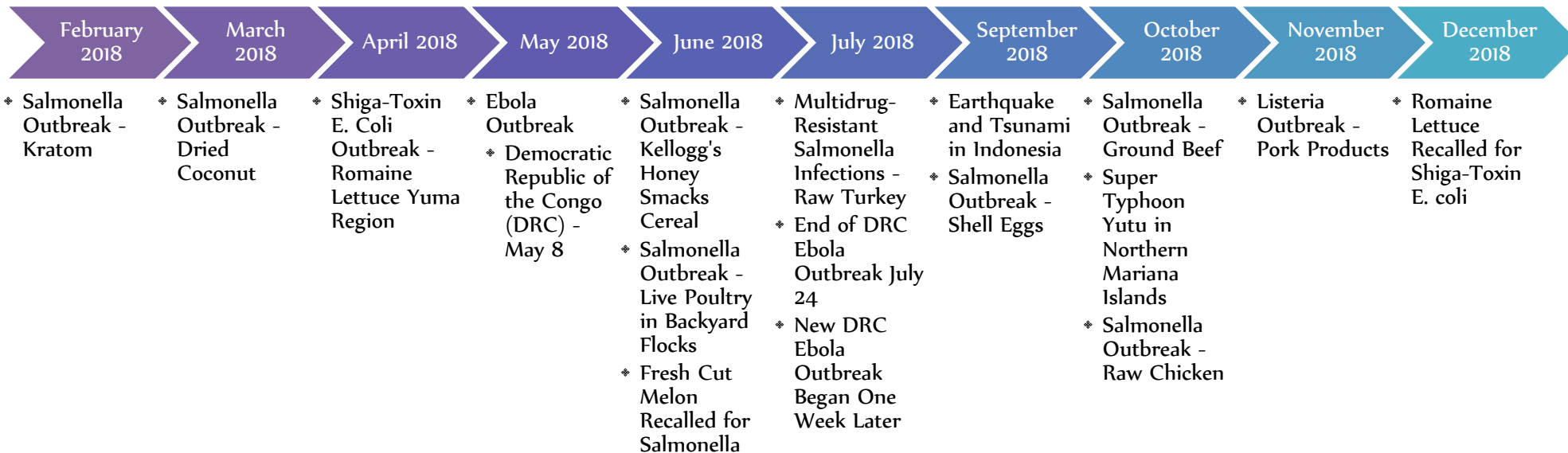

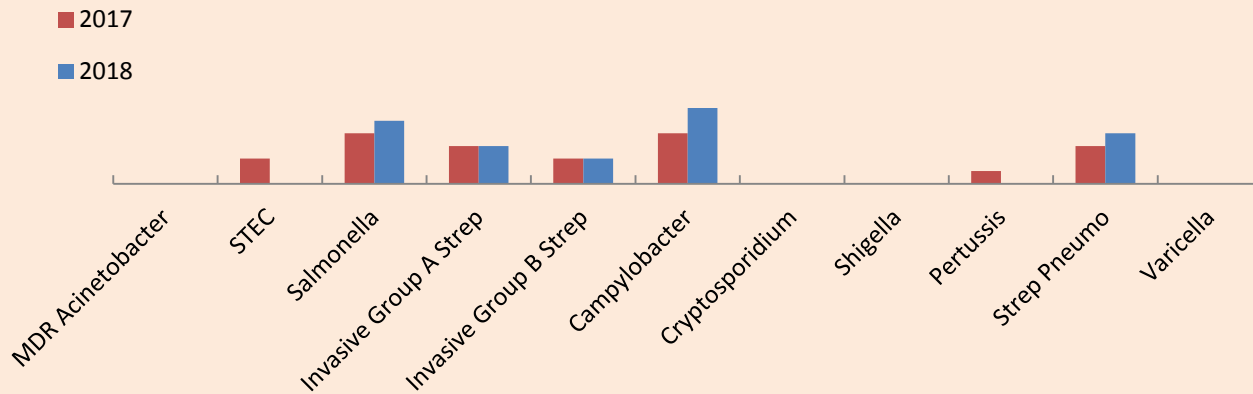
## Notable Outbreaks\*, Natural Disasters, and Recalls

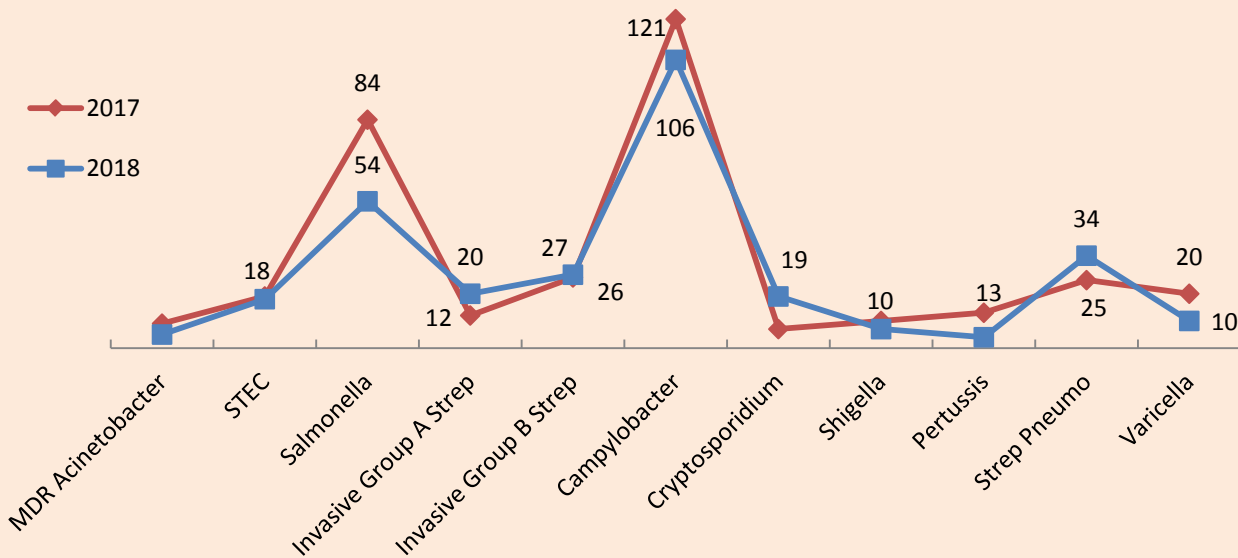
## 2017 and 2018 December Case Count Comparison of Selected Illness\* In Potter and Randall Counties

- Outbreaks: 17
- Notable Outbreaks: New York State, New York City, New Jersey
- Primary Source of Cases - Unvaccinated population

### Campylobacter

- Outbreaks: 1
- Notable Exposure: Pet Store Puppies
- Campy outbreaks are not commonly reported.
