



LOST PET TIPS



1. **Survey your property.**
 - a. Scared dogs and cats will hide. Cats are usually within 2 blocks from their home.
2. **Visit the animal shelter as often as possible** until you find your pet. Contact shelters within a 60 miles radius.
3. **Search your neighborhood**
 - a. Handout a recent photo of your pet or flyer
 - b. Tag your car with neon markers – put your pet’s description and your phone number.
 - c. Post lost pet posters – use neon poster board – in large print put 5 words that can be read in 5 seconds at 55 mph.
4. **Post flyers;** veterinary offices, pet supply stores, grocery stores, community centers, dog groomers, dog boarding and dog daycare. Notify rescues about your lost pet.
5. **Post on the internet;** lost/found pet sites such as helpinglostpets.com, lost/found social media pages, Craigslist, Nextdoor.com and your local newspaper.
6. **Be wary of scams.**
7. **Learn about lost dog and cat behavior on** www.missinganimalresponse.com.
8. **Do not give up! Keep searching and talking to everyone in your neighborhood including delivery people.**
