## PLANNING DEPARTMENT STAFF:

Chairman Parker opened the meeting, established a quorum and conducted the consideration of the following items in the order presented. Cris Valverde gave the recommendations for the agenda items.

- I. <u>Call to order and establish a quorum is present.</u>
- II. <u>Public Comment:</u> Citizens who desire to address the Planning and Zoning Commission with regard to matters on the agenda or having to do with policies, programs, or services will be received at this time. The total time allotted for comments is three (3) minutes per speaker. Planning and Zoning Commission may not discuss items not on this agenda, but may respond with factual, established policy information, or refer to staff. (*Texas Attorney General Opinion. JC-0169*)

No comments were made.

Cris Valverde, Assistant Director, presented the above-proposed Annexation. Mr. Valverde explained that a petition for a voluntary annexation was received by staff, however, in order to continue forward, State Law requires that Council officially direct staff to prepare a service plan detailing municipal services that will be provided. In March, the Council heard the annexation petition was considered and accepted. Mr. Valverde stated that staff was directed to prepare a service plan. Mr. Valverde advised that meetings with the Planning and Zoning Commission are not required but that an opportunity should be made for the Commission to discuss the proposed annexation. Mr. Valverde ended the presentation stating that the proposed annexation represents the continuation of the Heritage Hills Subdivision southward and consists of about 329 acres near Hollywood Rd and Soncy Rd/Loop 335. The land will hopefully be developed with single-family homes and other non-residential uses.

There was then a discussion between city staff and the Commission regarding the area.

Chairman Parker asked if there was anyone in favor or against this item. No comments were made.

There was another discussion between staff and the Commission regarding what the annexation would mean for the various services needed.
