From 1994 to 2005 the tournament was played on Saturday and Sunday with the rotation of Comanche Trail on Saturday morning and Amarillo CC in the afternoon, and Tascosa CC on Sunday morning and the final 18 holes at Ross Rogers on Sunday afternoon. The only exception was the 2001 tournament, when Saturday morning's round was at Ross Rogers and the final round was at Comanche Trail.

In 2006 the new-look Coors Tournament of Champions had the 72 holes contested Thursday-Sunday, with the normal rotation of ACC, TGC, Comanche Trail, and Ross Rogers.

Because of the reconstruction of Amarillo Country Club, the 2012 Coors Tournament was staged in order at Tascosa Golf Club, Comanche Trail Tomahawk, Comanche Trail Arrowhead, and Ross Rogers WildHorse.

In 2013 the Ross Rogers Mustang Course opened and became the anchor final round of the Coors TOC. The 7,227-yard Mustang was designed by Colligan Golf Design of Arlington, with Amarillo native Trey Kemp having a lot of input on the course. The TOC was staged in order at Ross Rogers WildHorse, Tascosa Golf Club, Comanche Trail Arrowhead, and the Mustang.

In late 2013 Amarillo Country Club re-opened to its members and was restored to the 2014 Coors TOC rotation – taking its normal opening Thursday spot, TGC's Tascosa Course moved back to Friday, followed by Comanche Trail Arrowhead and Ross Rogers Mustang courses over the weekend.

In 2015 the second round at Tascosa GC was played at the LaPaloma Course for the first time ever because of flooding damage at the Tascosa Course. In 2016 the second round at TGC moved back to the Tascosa Course. In 2018 the Tascosa Course became a par 71 venue.
