ITEM 1: Public Comments. No public comments.

ITEM 2: Call to Order and Approval of Minutes from Meeting held May 21, 2019. ITEM 3: The Parks and Recreation Board Will Discuss or Receive Reports on the Following Current Matters or Projects. Michael Kashuba, Director of Parks and Recreation, stated that the Thompson Pool Survey has received a strong response throughout the community and will close June 14th. This information will be submitted to the City Manager before it goes to Council. The Parks Master Plan will go to the Council on June 18th for approval. Upcoming special events include Starlight Cinema which is a free movie in the park to be held at Memorial Park on June 14th and will show "Lego Movie 2", July 26th will be at John Stiff Park featuring "How to Train Your Dragon 3" and August 9th at Thompson Park featuring "Wonder Park". ITEM 4: Present, Discuss and Consider Action on the Standards of Care for the Departments Youth Programs. Linda Pitner explained that the Standards of Care are necessary to exempt City Youth Programs from state child-care licensing requirements. These standards are intended to be the minimum standards by which the City of Amarillo Parks and Recreation Department will operate the City's Youth Programs. Motion was made by Mr. Rob Chafin and seconded by Mr. John Ingerson to approve recommendation to move forward with the potential to change based on any feedback from legal or HR.
