Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to State of Texas statues and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

ITEM #2 RESIDENTIAL HEATING SYSTEM:

IX. Instructions for Completing Application

GENERAL: Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with City of Amarillo Department of Building Safety. All installations shall be in conformance with the City of Amarillo Mechanical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected and approved.** The inspection telephone number will be provided on the permit form. When ready for inspection, call The Amarillo Department of Building Safety providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspection department will need the **job address** and **permit number**.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
