

## **Amarillo City Transit Half Fare Policy**

Reduced Fare Identification cards for disabled individuals, seniors, and students are issued free of charge by the City of Amarillo at the following location:

801 S.E. 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue

A **disabled** individual must have a yellow striped reduced fare identification card, Medicare Card, ACT-Connect™, or Disabled Veteran Card in order to pay the reduced fare or use a disabled ticket on a bus.

The yellow striped identification card will be issued to persons when certified as meeting one of the following qualifying conditions by their physician or qualified agency:

- Ambulatory Impairments – Impairments that cause a person to walk with difficulty. Persons using braces, crutches, canes or other mobility devices. Disabilities such as amputation, severe arthritis or spasticity are included.
- Visual Impairments – Total blindness or impairment affecting the sight to the extent that the individual functioning in public is insecure or exposed to danger.
- Hearing Impairments – Impairments that leave a person unable to communicate or hear warning devices.
- Disabilities or Coordination – Faulty coordination as a result of palsy or from a brain, spinal or peripheral nerve injury.
- Intellectual Impairment/Mental Illness – Individuals who are diagnosed with an intellectual impairment or mental illness.

A **senior** citizen must have a blue striped identification card or identification to determine age eligibility in order to pay the reduced fare or use a senior ticket on a bus. Blue striped reduced fare cards are issued once identification to determine age eligibility is presented.

A **student** must have a red striped identification card or student identification in order to pay the reduced fare or use a student ticket on a bus. Red striped reduced fare cards are issued once identification to determine student eligibility is presented.
