- 1: **REZONING/S**: The Planning and Zoning Commission will consider the following rezoning/s:
- A. Z-20-09 Rezoning of Lot 18, Block 2, Town Square Unit No. 6, in Section 63, Block 9, B.S.&F. Survey, Randall County, Texas, plus one-half of all bounding streets, alleys, and public ways to change from Planned Development 373A and Agricultural District to Amended Planned Development for Mixed Use Development.

 APPLICANT/S: James Bentley for East Village Park, LLC VICINITY: Town Square Blvd. and Soncy Rd.

Brady Kendrick, Planner II, presented the above-proposed rezoning request. Mr. Kendrick ended the presentation with staff recommendation of approval.
