**ITEM 1.** Minutes. Chairman Murguia called the meeting to order at 11:00AM. Chairman Murguia asked for corrections, deletions or changes to the minutes of August 15, 2019. A motion was made by Mr. Walker to approve the minutes, seconded by Mr. Attebury. Motion passed unanimously.

**ITEM 2.** Discuss and consider taking action on an application for TIRZ incentives associated with a project located at 7909 E IH 40, consisting of approximately 16.1 acres out of PRAD Property ID's R-001-5500-0530.0; R-044-3970-1000.0; and R-044-3970-5050.0. Andrew started the discussion, giving an overview of the request. Greg Mitchell, applicant, stood to further discuss the site plan, operations, and future hopes for the land us. He then took questions from the board regarding expectations of use and overall look as well as the timeline to complete the project. Chairman Murguia asked if there was any one for or against this item. No comments were made.

Chairman Murguia asked Mr. McWilliams to begin the executive session. Executive session began at 11:24AM.

ITEM 2. (continued) A motion was made by Mr. Walker to approve 90% for the first 5 years followed by 50% for the next 5 years after that with a cap of 1 million dollars upon obtaining a permit in 3 months from agreement and 18 months to obtain a certificate of occupancy. Mr. Mitchell asked the board for further reasoning regarding the final approval. There was a discussion the reasons for approval made.

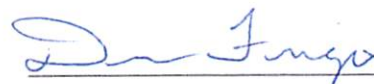
