Community service hours must be performed at a nonprofit *OR* faith-based organization. All nonprofit organizations must operate under section 501(c)(3) of Title 26 of the Internal Revenue Code. This is a list of approved nonprofit organizations in Amarillo. Review the list and any restrictions that may be listed, contact the agency of your choice and complete the hours as required.

If an organization is not listed, please contact the Court Community Programs Coordinator at (806) 378-5232 or email courtprograms@amarillo.gov to provide the agency information, a contact name and number, and proof of 501(c)(3) verification PRIOR to beginning community service hours. The Court Community Programs Coordinator must verify nonprofit status of any organization not listed below BEFORE community service hours will be accepted.
