ITEM 1: Public Comments. Rev Nell commented on the damaged trees in the parks and along the hiking trails due to mowers and tree trimmers and suggested using mulch around the trees to protect them.

Chairman, Mr. John Ingerson, established a quorum and called the regularly scheduled meeting of the Parks and Recreation Board to order at 1:30 p.m. A unanimous vote was given by all attended Board Members to approve such minutes as written.

ITEM 3: The Parks and Recreation Board Will Discuss or Receive Reports on the Following Current Matters or Projects. Michael Kashuba, Director of Parks and Recreation, updated the Parks and Recreation Board on the Director's Report, the City's planning to open the parks during COVID-19, Thompson Park Pool, Parks Master Plan and future agenda items.

The Director updated the Board on the opening of facilities with social distancing and what remains closed due to the direction of the Governor of the State of Texas, Order GA18 that supersedes all local guidance. Mr. Luke Austin, along with Ms. Angela Harney, expressed concerns on the closing of the outdoor pools, the impact it would have on the community and the lack of board involvement. Other concerns were for Park Board members to have more input on surveys in the future. Future agenda items requested: Asset Management Plan, development of exiting open space areas and bike trails.
