- Item 1. <u>Call to Order and Announcements.</u> Chair Jason Boyett called the meeting to order at 11:48 am. Sherman Bass thanked Marcus Norris for filling in for Courtney White. No other announcements were made.
- Item 2. **Public Forum.** No members of the public were present.
- Item 3. <u>Discuss and Consider Minutes.</u> Chair Boyett asked if there were any changes to the minutes for the meeting on 3/10/20. Councilmember Eddy Sauer motioned to approve the minutes as presented. Andi Wardlaw seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- the board that the City has suspended non-essential spending due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Mr. Bass asked the board to consider releasing program funds for the current fiscal year so that portion of the budget can be otherwise available. Chair Boyett asked if other non-essential City projects are suspended, which Councilmember Sauer confirmed. Mr. Bass stated he would contact all applicants and encourage them to reapply for the program re-launch. Angela Knapp-

Eggers motioned to approve canceling this fiscal year's Mural Grant Program with the intent of a FY 2020-2021 continuation. Ms. Wardlaw seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

- Item 5. <u>Discuss and Consider Canceling FY19 Beautification Project.</u> Chair Boyett advised the board that they should consider cancelation for the FY19 Beautification Project as well. Councilmember Sauer stated that he would be in support of cancelation and asked the board to continue progress on the project in the interim with the intention of launching the project at the start of FY 2020-2021. Ms. Wardlaw motioned to suspend this fiscal year's Beautification Project with the intent of continuing research and development, and the intent of a FY 2020-2021 continuation. Beth Duke seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- Night of Artists and Chefs update. Chair Boyett stated he intended to advise the board about the Night of Artists and Chefs event at previously scheduled meetings, but the event was rescheduled due to COVID-19 concerns. Chair Boyett explained this is a PBS series in the making, bringing local chefs and local artists together to create an experimental restaurant experience that highlights the host city. On-camera work has already been done by Chair Boyett, touring murals, Hoof Prints, and other works of public art. Chair Boyett stated the series should be good for tourism and promotion of the local art scene. This event has been rescheduled for August and tickets will be available online.
