Habitually- Do you do this activity habitually (often, regularly, frequently)?

Verify-Could you verify (authenticate, confirm, validate) this?

Marital Status- Are you single, married, divorced, or widowed?

Swear- Do you swear (promise) that you agree to...?

Registered- When did you register (sign up for)?

Spouse- Is your spouse (husband, wife) with you today?

Current Home Address- What is your Current Home Address (where you live)?

Date of Birth- What is your date of birth (when you were born)?

Advocated- Have you ever advocated (supported) this organization?

Failed To- Have you ever failed to (didn't do)...?

Federal- Do you support the federal (United States) government?

Exempt- Are you exempt (don't have to do) from ...?

Prior- Prior (before) to the year 2000 did you ever...?

Pending- How long has your application been pending (being processed)?

Have You Ever- Have you ever (at least once, anytime before this) did you do this actions?

Member- Are you a member (part of) this group or organization?

Resident- Are you a resident (live in) of Amarillo?

Requested- Have you requested (asked for) this information?

Disability- Do you have any sort of disability (impaired)?

Dependents- Do you have any dependents (people that you financially support)?

Genocide- systematic destruction of a racial, political, or cultural group

Hereditary- of or relating to inheritance, passed down through the family

Bear Arms- Fight in the military

Armed Forces- Military organizations

Civilian Direction- under the supervision of someone not in the military

Tranquility- Peace

Posterity- Children's Children

Torture- Harming someone to cause pain

Owe- Obligation to pay or repay

Cold War- a state of political hostility between countries characterized by threats, without open warfare

Emancipation- the fact or process of being set free

Diplomat- an official representing a country abroad

Claimed- Stating that something is true

Election- Time to vote

Title- Name for royalty like King, Queen, Duke

Nobility- Family of royal people. The king's family

Foreign- outside the U.S

Incompetent- Cannot take care of yourself

Confined- Locked up

Mental Institution- a place where they help mental hospital

Overdue- Money you have not paid yet. It is late

Local taxes- city taxes

Involved in, member of, in any way associated with- Part of a group of people

Organization, association, fund, foundation, party, club, society, or similar group- A group/gathering of people for a common cause
