The following information will be discussed and reviewed: The City anticipates receiving entitlement funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the amounts of \$1,695,314 from Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, \$720,963 from HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) funds. As required by federal regulations, CDBG funds may be used to support projects that assist low-income citizens, remove slum and blight, or for urgent needs (disaster relief). Eligible activities may include Affordable Housing projects, such as Housing Rehabilitation, Emergency Rehabilitation, Handicapped Accessibility, Homebuyers Assistance, and Acquisition; Public Services; Code Enforcement; Economic Development, Demolition; and improvements to Public Facilities, such as Parks, Streets, and Community Centers.**
