4. Resolution – Calling a Public Hearing to determine whether certain conditions described herein constitute a Public Nuisance at the locations stated:

This resolution sets the date and time for a public hearing on March 18, 2021, at 4:00 p.m. to determine whether certain conditions of the property at 407 S Osage Street constitute a dangerous structure and/or a public nuisance, and whether to order the removal of such. A copy of this resolution will be mailed to all interested parties providing ten (10) days notice of public hearing.
