Timeline and Meeting Schedule

• MARCH 1

• **Planning and Zoning Meeting**

Proposal is tabled. P&Z requests further outreach and for the proposal to come back in smaller pieces, possibly two parts.

• MID APRIL •

NHAA co-hosts informational workshops with city staff, collects community input.

• MID MAY

NHAA holds community meetings, presenting the final rezoning proposal to be submitted to Planning and Zoning Commission.

• JUNE 2 •

Legal notices mailed for P&Z's consideration of revised proposal (Part 1 of 2). Notices are mailed to affected properties, and neighbors who might not be changing. *Tentative.*

• JUNE 14

• **Planning and Zoning Meeting - Part 1**

P&Z will reconsider the proposal for recommendation to City Council.

• JULY 13 •

• **City Council Meeting - Part 1**

City Council will consider the P&Z

recommendations. *Tentative.* In-person meetings have resumed at City Hall, 601 S. Buchanan Street.

Those wishing to speak will have the opportunity.

Council can approve as recommended by P&Z, approve with changes, or not approve.

Second reading - July 27th.
