SAN JACINTO ARTS RULES

- 1. Artists may work in any medium. Works that hang must be no larger than 60". 3-D pieces must be no larger than 60".
- 2. Artists may submit up to three pieces for consideration.
- 3. Artists should stick with the historical locations from the official list. Artists are free to create on site or from photographs. Remember that many of these locations are occupied. Do not enter any of the locations at any time unless you have permission. Be considerate of the people that live and/or work at these sites and respect their privacy.
- 4. If you select a school as your site, you may only work on school property when school is not in session. No exceptions!
- 5. All work must be family-friendly.
- 6. Once your work is complete, send completed entry form and a photo of the work to president@SJNAmarillo.org . We prefer email entries, but you can mail as well, or drop them off at Time Passages at 3217 6th St. All entries must be received by Thursday September 23, 2021.
- 7. All work must be complete and ready to hang or display.
- 8. The San Jacinto Arts Committee has final say on works to be exhibited. Artists will be notified by email or phone as to the decisions of the Committee.
- 9. Selected artwork must be delivered to The Rockin OT, 3100 W 6th Ave, on September 29 from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. Work delivered after this deadline will not be included in the exhibition.
- 10.Accepted works will be displayed at the Rockin' OT from September 30 October 1.
- 11.Artists and friends are encouraged to attend the opening reception/gala event on Thursday evening. Attendees will have the opportunity to vote for People's Choice Award at the premier. Awards will be announced on Saturday, October 1.
- 12.All art will be for sale during the exhibition at a price set by the artist. Artists may opt to receive 50% of the sales price. All other proceeds benefit the San Jacinto Neighborhood Projects.
