The following information will be discussed and reviewed for final recommendations to City Council: The City anticipates receiving entitlement funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the amounts of \$1,647,145 from Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds \$706,565 from HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) funds. As required by federal regulations, CDBG funds may be used to support projects that assist low-income citizens, remove slum and blight, or for urgent needs (disaster relief). Eligible activities may include


Affordable Housing projects, such as Housing Rehabilitation, Emergency Rehabilitation, Handicapped Accessibility, Homebuyers Assistance, and Acquisition; Public Services; Code Enforcement; Economic Development, Demolition; and improvements to Public Facilities, such as Parks, Streets, and Community Centers.

III. Public Comment: This Public Hearing Webinar seeks input from the local community with particular emphasis on serving persons of low and moderate incomes. Interested parties are encouraged to attend the webinar and provide comments on housing and community development needs. The plan will also be posted for comment on the City's website <http://comdev.amarillo.gov>.
