Adopted as official amendments to the **Amarillo Comprehensive Plan**, they shape future policy decisions and help direct resources to the plan area. Plans in Amarillo broadly address the opportunities and challenges identified by area residents, property owners, business owners.



Neighborhood Plan Fast Facts...

Partnership.

The Neighborhood Planning Initiative was created through an interlocal agreement in 2016 by the City and Potter County to help revitalize some of Amarillo's older neighborhoods.

Investment.

The first four neighborhoods in the initiative have **\$654,050** each to allocate to public improvements in public right-of-way areas, including streets, sidewalks, and alleys.

Community.

The Neighborhood Plan is an opportunity for citizens to take a proactive role in the planning process and decide how their neighborhoods will move in the future.

Collaboration.

Neighborhood Associations consist of community members share ideas and work together as one unified voice to organize projects that will improve the state of their community.
