Mr. Wright established a quorum, called the regularly scheduled meeting of the Amarillo-Potter Events Venue District Board of Directors to order at 8:35 a.m. and the following items of business were conducted:

Public Address: There were no comments.

<u>ITEM 1:</u> Consider minutes. Mr. Wright presented the minutes from the August 16, 2021 meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Mayfield to approve the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Mr. Reed and it carried unanimously.

<u>ITEM 2</u>: Presentation of quarterly financials. Ms. Storrs presented the unaudited September 30, 2021 Amarillo-Potter Events Venue District Balance Sheet and Income Statement. Total assets of \$6,613,754 and liabilities of \$67,307, leaves a fund equity balance of \$6,546,447.

<u>ITEM 3</u>: Discuss and consider events at the Amarillo National Center. Ms. Storrs presented a summary of the events that have been paid for at the Tri-State Fairgrounds through September 30, 2021, stating \$259,033 has been spent out of the \$200,000 budget. Ms. Storrs mentioned that the overage was caused by the amounts paid to the State for the USTPA and CMSA event trust fund participation that

were offset by revenue coming back in from the State. A motion was made by Mr. Mayfield to approve the item as presented, Mr. Patel seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

<u>ITEM 4:</u> Discuss and consider payments to the Amarillo National Center. Ms. Storrs presented the item and stated the overall spending through September 30, 2021 was \$181,582 with a budget of \$239,130. A motion was made by Mr. Mayfield to approve the item as presented, Mr. Patel seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

<u>ITEM 5:</u> Update on projects at the Fairgrounds and Civic Center. Mr. Bass updated the Board that the Civic Center approved projects were underway and would hopefully be completed within the next several months. Mr. Bartlett updated the Board on all the projects at the Tri-State Fairgrounds and that none were experiencing issues, and all should be completed in a timely manner.

There being no further business, Mr. Wright adjourned the meeting at 9:27 a.m.
