### 3 Projects in Motion

#### **3 Updated Projects in Motion:**

1. **10<sup>th</sup> Avenue Streetscape Project** Total Cost- \$3,644,378.55 – Raised & received \$2,142,354.43. **Need \$1.55 million dollars** by June 2023.
  - Next Steps: City of Amarillo gave \$565,000 for this project from the 2016 Proposition 1 Bond – we will use \$447,609.00 as a match to the TXDOT grant with \$113,000 left over for the 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue streetscape project.
  - **In 2021, applied for 11 grants & received 9: TXDOT Transportation Alternative federal grant (approved 10/28/21-\$1,790,434), C.J. and Syble Fowlston Foundation (received \$10,000), The Kimble Foundation Trust (received \$10,000), Dr. Kent and Ilene Roberts Balliett Foundation (received \$10,000), Josephine Anderson Charitable Trust (received \$5,000), Amarillo Business Foundation (anonymous; received \$20,000), Atmos Energy Foundation (received-\$2,500), Education Credit Union (received \$1,000), & Ware Foundation (received \$25,000).** The Brumley Foundation denied our grant proposal on 10/7/21 since our project didn't meet their funding criteria.
  - In 2022, we will apply for 14 grants and 3 business donations: Happy State Bank, Caviness Beef Packers, Fiesta Foods, City Federal Credit Union grant, Amarillo Area Foundation economic grant (10% of total funding- apply in June), Mary E. Bivins Foundation (apply in May), Bank of America- (apply in June), Tyson Meats Foundation (apply in Nov), FirstBank Southwest (apply in June), AT&T Corporate Funding, BOC Bank, Interstate Bank, First Bank & Trust, Don & Sybil Harrington Foundation, and State Farm Neighborhood Grant (apply in October & funds are available in 2023)
  - In 2023, we will apply for funding to buy cedar elm tree (192 trees) from the Atmos Energy's Call Before You Dig program.
  - In 2023, sell up to 2,000 personalized brick pavers (4x4 or 8x8) around the street lamps and up to 85 street lamps to individuals, families, organizations, and businesses as a fundraiser – board will determine the prices for the brick pavers.
2. **3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Business and Owner List**
  - Next Step: Gather a list of 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue businesses & business owners for future revitalization.
    - Timeline: December 2023
3. **3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Underpass Murals**
  - Next Step: Ask for sponsorship(s) to pay for artist(s) and supplies: \$100,000 estimate. How will the sponsor(s) be recognized? Ask the City of Amarillo if the donor(s) logo and/or name may be included on the mural?
    - Timeline: December 2025
