

# Sidewalk Cost-Share Pilot Program Information

By Amarillo City Code **(Sec. 4-6-187)**, property owners are responsible for the maintenance and repair of damaged sidewalks. These unmaintained sidewalks can be considered a public nuisance and dangerous to pedestrians. Since this type of maintenance can be costly, a cost-share pilot program is being offered to San Jacinto residents to provide funding assistance from the neighborhood plan bond money.

## **Eligible Properties**

Property owners of the following types of owner properties are eligible to participate in the program: single-family residences, duplexes, and town homes. Sidewalks eligible for repair are those within the City's right-of-way and intended for public pedestrian access. Reconstruction or repair will not be performed on private property. Drive-way ramps are eligible. Curbs and gutters are the responsibility of the City of Amarillo and will not be charged to the property owner.

## <u>Cost</u>

The City of Amarillo and property owner will split the cost based upon income that is noted in the policy for the program.

## <u>Trees</u>

All trees located in the City's right-of-way considered to be an obstacle for repair will be removed with each project. The cost of removal will be included in the estimate of each project.

## Method of Payment

The property owner must pay the City the full amount of their share of the project cost before any sidewalk repair begins OR make payments through a payment agreement with 12 to 18 monthly installments. The agreement must be completed with the City with the first payment due before any sidewalk repair begins. Property owners may make a written request for a refund before reconstruction begins. **No refunds will be made after the City begins work.** 

### How to Apply

Preliminary applications will be available on the San Jacinto Neighborhood Association website **sjnamarillo.org** or by phone (**806**) **632-9479**. Return your completed application to SJNA for review. After SJNA approval, your application will then be forwarded to the City of Amarillo for a cost estimate and final approval. After cost estimate is shared with you (the property owner), you will sign the application again acknowledging the formal cost-share agreement.
