### 1. PUBLIC COMMENT

#### 2. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD ON AUGUST 19, 2021

A motion to approve the December 16, 2021 minutes as written was made by Tim Dillon and seconded by Roger Gloe. The motion passed with a 5-0 vote.

### 3. DISCUSS OR RECEIVE REPORTS ON THE FOLLOWING CURRENT MATTERS OR PROJECTS:

- **a. Illegal Dumping Task Force –** Donny Hooper discussed the Illegal Dumping Task Force, comprised of key players in City management. Topics included: Background, Challenges, Big and Bulky Pickup Program, Alley Cleanup Statistics, Ordinance Enhancements, Surveillance and Public Education.
- b. Cardboard Recycling Project This item was tabled due to the absence of Adam Schaer.

#### 4. BRAINSTORM PUBLIC EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

The Task Force members discussed educational opportunities, including: IEEE meeting presentations, water conservation updates, composting and diverting lawn waste utilizing programs such as "Don't Bag It". Tim Dillon will coordinate with IEEE; Donny Hooper will get an update on water conservation from Utilities staff; and David Moody will obtain information regarding the "Don't Bag It" program. Reports will be provided and topics discussed at the next Task Force meeting.
