



NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY **EXTENSION** Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership Program 2022-2023

AMARILLO –The City of Amarillo is now accepting applications from local non-profit and community organizations that wish to apply for fiscal year funding (October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023). Funding is for CDBG entitlement grant from U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD).

A 5-day application extension has been granted. Applications are due no later than 6 p.m. on Sunday (June 12.)

The City of Amarillo received notice of funding allocation for FY 2022-2023:

CDBG - \$1,584,592 HOME - \$828,236

The City of Amarillo wishes to provide financial support for eligible activities and projects that meet the purpose of the CDBG Programs. Projects supported should meet a local priority need identified in the Consolidated Plan. Identified priorities for FY 2022-2023 include serving the homeless population and Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA). TBRA will be funded by the HOME program through the City of Amarillo.

Recommendations will be assessed by priority needs and presented to the Community Development Advisory Committee (CDAC) in which public meetings will be held for final recommendations and allocation of funding prior to City Council approval
