- c. Cardboard Recycling Program This item was tabled due to the absence of Adam Schaer.
- d. **Earth Day Update –** Donny Hooper stated that the initial goal was 80 tons, and a total of 191.4 tons was collected during Earth Day week. Dumpsters were placed in the 4 quadrants. City employees and neighborhood groups participated. Eastridge is continuing with a monthly cleanup.
- **e. Other Public Education Opportunities –** Autumn leaf disposal was mentioned and will be discussed in greater detail at the next meeting.
