- 2. Approval of Minutes** This item is for the Commission to discuss and consider approval of the Condemnation Appeals Commission minutes of the regular meeting held on March 16, 2023.
- 3. Resolution – Calling a Public Hearing to determine whether certain conditions described herein constitute a Public Nuisance at the locations stated:** This resolution sets the date and time for a public hearing on May 18, 2023, at 4:00 p.m. to determine whether certain conditions of the properties located at 4209 SE 15th Avenue, 3405 Hancock Street, and 617 N Pierce Street (aka 312 NE 7th Avenue and 316 NE 7th Avenue) constitute dangerous structures and/or a public nuisance, and whether to order the removal of such. A copy of this resolution will be mailed to all interested parties providing ten (10) days' notice of public hearing.
- 4. Resolution – Public Hearing** This resolution conducts a public hearing on and considers ordering the removal of substandard structures and an accumulation of solid waste located at 3000 Curtis Drive.
- 5. Resolution – Public Hearing** This resolution conducts a public hearing on and considers ordering the removal of solid waste accumulation located at 308 N McMasters Street.
- 6. Resolution – Public Hearing** This resolution conducts a public hearing on and considers ordering the removal of solid waste accumulation located at 310 N McMasters Street.
