Sec. 4-4-46. Electrical Code adopted; amendments.

Code adopted. For all buildings, structures, and electrical installations under the jurisdiction of the City of Amarillo, there is hereby adopted the NFPA 70, National Electrical Code, 2014 2020 Edition, published by the National Fire Protection Association, copies of which shall be maintained by the Building Official.

(Add)

Article 90.4 Enforcement; add the following language:

(A) Supervision of Work: In the actual work of installing, maintaining, altering, or repairing any electrical conductors or equipment which requires a permit, apprentice electricians shall be directly supervised by a higher-grade classification of electrical license as described in Subchapter A, Section 1305.002 of the TDLR Texas Electrical Safety and Licensing Act when electrical work is being performed. Each higher-grade classification supervisor shall be limited to directly supervising 4 apprentices.

Informational Note No. 1: As defined by the State of Texas in Title 8, Occupational Code Chapter 1305 administered by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation for the proper grade classifications of electrical license.

Article 100; add the following to definitions:

<u>Engineering Supervision</u>. Supervision by a Qualified State of Texas Licensed Professional Engineer engaged in the <u>design or maintenance of electrical installations</u>.
