If you are interested in being a food truck at this event, please fill out the application and turn it in by 5/15/24.

Important information:

If you are selected to participate as a food truck vendor for Independence +1, below are the requirements:

- 1. You will be required to pay a \$50 Parks & Recreation Vendor Permit fee 10 business days prior to the event date (Staff will call you 10 days before to collect payment over the phone).
- 2. You will be required to apply for a Temporary Food Establishment permit through Environmental Health UNLESS you already have an active Catering License. The permit fee is \$45 and must be paid 2 full working days in advance of the event. A late fee will be attached to the cost if received late. All food trucks are subject to inspection on site at the event. Environmental Health: 806-378-9472
- **3.** Brand new food trucks who have never had a Fire Marshall's Office Inspection will need to pay an inspection fee through their office. Please contact 806-378-6096.

Selection Criteria

- **1.** Amarillo Parks & Recreation Outreach Subcommittee will be selecting the food truck vendors for this event.
- 2. Only a limited number of applications will be accepted.
- **3.** The Parks Board will be trying to balance the number of food & beverage trucks and select a variety of food categories.
- **4.** Preference will be given to those who submit their applications first.
- **5.** Late applications will not be considered.
