

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

AMARILLO METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION

The Amarillo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will hold a public meeting for consideration of the revision of the **2025-28 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**.

The MTP and the TIP are financially constrained planning documents. The 2025-2050 MTP is a blueprint for development of future transportation improvements for the Amarillo Metropolitan Area. Amarillo's TIP documents are developed to implement transportation projects identified in the MTP. The TIP is a financially constrained planning document. The 2025-28 TIP contains federally funded projects with cost estimates and funding sources, as identified in the long-range plan. Transportation projects done within the Amarillo MPO's boundary must be in the TIP to be eligible for federal funding.
