Common Rabies Symptoms in Animals

- Abnormal Behavior
- Loss of Appetite
- Paralysis
- Fever
- Seizures
- Excessive Drooling

Rabies is spread from bites or scratches.

Seek medical attention immediately if exposed.

03



Avoid contact with wild animals.

04



Teach children to avoid unfamiliar animals.

05



Keep your animal's vaccinations up to date.

If bitten by an unfamiliar animal, you should:

- Thoroughly wash the wound
- Seek medical attention
