- ITEM 1. Consider Minutes**
Approval of the minutes from the meeting held on October 11, 2012
- ITEM 2. Consider Election of Officers**
The Board will elect the following officers: president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer of the Board.
- ITEM 3. Presentation of Financial Statements**
City staff will present the Corporation's latest statement of net assets, revenue, expenses and changes in net assets.
- ITEM 4. Consideration of Bylaws**
The Corporation's bylaws state that the Corporation will review its bylaws annually. There are no changes recommended by City staff.
- ITEM 5. Consideration of Investment Policy**
The Public Funds Investment Act requires an annual review of investment policies.
- ITEM 6. Consider Approval of Investment Training with the University of North Texas**
Per the Public Funds Investment Act, an investment officer may receive training from any independent source approved by the governing body of the state agency.
- ITEM 7. Public Forum**
Interested citizens may comment on matters pertaining to policies, programs or services of the Amarillo Health Facilities Corporation or this Board.
