(a) HAZMAT Report: Randall County & Amarillo response to a truck fire at Affiliated Foods; 01/17/15.

(b) Level I HAZMAT: Amarillo response to a abandoned drum at Grand & SE 15th St.; 01/19/15.

(c) Level I HAZMAT: Amarillo response to a release of ~700 gallons of ethylene glycol by a contractor at the airport; 01/20/15.

4. Presentation and Discussion of Annex Q, Hazardous Materials Response Plan Revision. Annex Q of the Amarillo/Potter/Randall Emergency Operations Plan is required to be revised and approved by September 2015. Discussion on revision process and the role of the LEPC to assist with the revision.

5. Presentation and Consideration of LEPC Participation in Business Connection. The Potter & Randall County LEPC will be presented information on the 2015 Business Connection event and consider taking action on participation in the event.

5. Public Forum - Interested citizens may comment on matters pertaining to policies, programs or services of the Amarillo/Potter/Randall Office of Emergency Management or this Committee that are not on this agenda.
