

# Dental Plan

The City's Dental Plan is administered through Aetna.

Plan Feature	Dental Plan – PPO <i>You have In and Out of Network dental benefits. The same benefit applies to both In and Out of Network dentists.</i>
<b>Annual Deductible</b> Individual Family	\$50 \$100
<b>Annual Benefit Maximum per person</b>	\$1,000
<b>Preventive Services</b> – no waiting period applies (Exams, routine cleanings, fluoride treatments, space maintainers)	100% (no deductible)
<b>Basic Services</b> – For new dental enrollees benefits are only available after member has been enrolled for 3 months (X-rays, fillings, periodontics, sealants, denture repairs)	80% after deductible
<b>Major Services</b> – For new dental enrollees benefits are only available after member has been enrolled for 12 months (Crowns, inlays, onlays, bridges, dentures)	50% after deductible
<b>Orthodontia</b> – only for dependent children 18 years of age or younger. For new dental enrollees benefits are only available after member has been enrolled for 12 months	\$1,500 per Lifetime (payable in increments of \$500 per year)

## Dental ID Cards

- You will not receive an ID Card for dental services.
  - When visiting a dentist, simply provide your name, date of birth and Member ID# (or social security number).
  - You will receive a letter from Aetna explaining how to access dental services.
