The City of Amarillo announces the availability of the 2013-2014 Public Housing Agency (PHA) Annual Plan, which provides comprehensive and specific information about the operation of the City's rental assistance programs. The plan identifies the needs of low and very low-income families for assistance and outlines the strategies for addressing those needs through policies and resources. The Tenant Advisory Board assisted in the development of the plan.

Citizen Review and Comment Period

The City of Amarillo is seeking public comment on the Annual PHA Plan. The Plan is available for public review for 45 days. The comment period begins on Wednesday, May 1, 2013 and ends on Saturday, June 15, 2013.

The Plan is available in the Community Development Department, Room 104 of City Hall, 509 E. 7th Street. The Plan is also available on the City's web page at http://www.amarillo.gov/?page_id=119

Following the 45-day comment period, the Amarillo City Commission will conduct a public hearing to allow citizens the opportunity to comment on the 2013-2014 Annual PHA Plan. If no revisions are made to the Plan as a result of the final hearing, the Plan as proposed will be published for community distribution and will be submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for approval.
